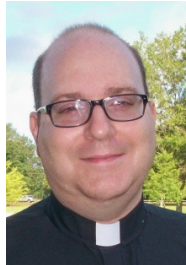
The biker fund raiser for us was a great success and we are indebted to *Brian Bosarge* for being our guest chef. Thanks to all who helped.
