January Meeting Highlights

The Meeting was called to order by *President Daniel* at 7pm. *Fr. Charles* led the members present in the opening prayers and the Holy Name Pledge. *President Daniel* led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Warner stated that he had no remarks but went on to say he felt 2015 was a good year and is looking forward to 2016 and then introduced two new

members, *Jerry Brantley* and *John Travers*. Both were accepted by member vote.

There were no changes to November minutes and were adopted as written.

Treasurer *John Karpa* reported a balance of \$5,559 in the checking account at the end of November. Additionally he reported a balance of \$4,823 at the end of December. There was a \$700 expense for shrimp purchased for the fish frys. The savings account has \$2,560

Old Business:

Fr. Charles had nothing to report from the Pastoral Council.

Warner reported that the Saturday work day went well and a lot was accomplished.

Mel stated there was no need for any new equipment needed for the fish frys. *Gus* and *Mel* are going to build a defrosting table to ease this process. The shrimp has been purchased. Help will be needed from 9am to closing on fish Fridays. Members were reminded to pick up their fish fry tickets. They are in the Ushers room. Please try to sell them before the fry days.

Please remember and try to attend the Corporate on January 24th with the Altar Society. Breakfast will be served after Mass.

New Business

Mel asked the members to consider buying new signs for the fish frys. They look like a feather stuck in the ground and cost \$150 each. He recommends purchasing two. *Don* moved and *Wayne* seconded and the motion passed.

John Karpa recommended that we close the savings account. It is very seldom used and earns little interest. *Vern* moved that we give \$1000 to the Altar Society and the balance to the building fund. *Gus* seconded the motion. Motion carried. *John* will do the necessary transactions.

Wayne reported a gain of 6 new members in 2015. He stressed the need to sell Fish Fry tickets.

Fr. Charles commented on how nice the Christmas décor looked in and outside the Church. *Wayne* moved that we give the Church \$500 to help pay for the new decorations. *Richard* seconded. Motion carried.

Adjourn and Closing Prayers

Tom moved for adjournment and was seconded by *Mel*. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 PM. *Fr. Charles* led the members in the closing prayers.
