9/15 Our first fund raiser was held for the year; we fed John Supan's bike organization about 190 meals at \$8.00 each.

10/15 Regular meeting with no activities.

11/15 We sponsored a parish wide work party for all men of the parish which was well attended with much work being accomplished. Fr Charles prepared hamburgers for all.

Our first corporate communion was held with the Altar Society along with a pot luck supper. Neither event was well

attended. The lack of attendance of the mass and the pot luck supper by both memberships prompted a careful review of future corporate communions.

12/15 There is never a HN meeting scheduled in December. The HN was invited to attend the Altar Society Christmas Luncheon at Young's which was well attended.

01/16 Regular meeting, discussion held and plans made for our first fish fry in February.

02/16 Regular meeting with plans finalized for our fish fry fund raisers, & our first fish fry was held. A fish defrosting station was built to make it easier to defrost fish.

03/16 Regular meeting held and the two remaining fish fries done; a very successful fund raising event.

The HM took control of the Easter Egg Hunt this year which was well attended and a great success.

04/16 A parish wide work party for all men of the parish held with good attendance, much work accomplished and Fr Charles contributed a crayfish boil with all the trimmings at the end.

05/16 Regular meeting. We voted to purchase a commercial refrigerator for the church at a cost of \$1799.00 which arrived and has been installed.

06/16 Regular meeting. We voted to make payment to the various ministries of the church and to the several outside of St Benedict.

We have commitments to donate \$5160.00 this year in addition to \$8750.50 paid through 5/17/16. We are truly blessed to be able to make donations in these numbers. We are also blessed to have the devoted membership we have in our little HN Society. We voted in new member, Clint Jacob, this month; Clint was our tenth new member for the year.

Fr. Charles Benoit, O.S.B.

On July 11th, we celebrate the solemn feast of our patron, St. Benedict. He was born into a distinguished family in central Italy, studied at Rome and early in life was drawn to the monastic life. At first he became a hermit, leaving a depressing world—pagan

armies on the march, the Church torn by schism, people suffering from war, morality at a low ebb. He soon realized that he could not live a hidden life in a small town any better than in a large city, so he withdrew to a cave high in the mountains. Some monks chose him as their leader for a while, but found his strictness not to their taste. He had an idea of gathering monks into one monastery to give them the benefit of unity, fraternity, permanent worship in one house. Finally he began to build what was to become one of the most famous monasteries in the world: Monte Cassino. He wrote a *Rule*, which he said was for beginners, that gradually developed prescribed a life of liturgical prayer, study, manual labor and living together in

community under a common father (abbot). Benedictine asceticism is known for its moderation, and Benedictine hospitality and charity has always shown concern for others. May our patron lead us to become men of prayer, community, work, and hospitality.
