Welcome Father Charles to St. Benedict's

We extend a warm welcome to an old friend, Fr. Charles Benoit, OSB and look forward to him being our new pastor.



Fr. Charles was born in Luling, Louisiana, on March 12, 1974, where his parents and his sister and her family still live. After graduating from Hahnville High School in 1992, he began studies for the priesthood at Saint Joseph Seminary College. He joined Saint Joseph Abbey in

1996, making his first profession of vows on July 10, 1997. He continued his priestly formation at Notre Dame Seminary and received a Masters Degree in Historical Theology in 2001. He was ordained to the priesthood on April 21, 2001.

Since ordination Fr. Charles has been on the faculty of Saint Joseph Seminary and has held many administrative positions including Dean of Students, Vice Rector, Procurator, and most recently Academic Dean. He has also served as a chaplain to KC Camp Abbey and the Carmelite Nuns. In the monastery, he has held numerous positions including Procurator, Subprior, member of the Abbot's Council, and Master of Ceremonies. From 2009-2012 Fr. Charles studied canon law at The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C.

Before becoming Academic Dean of the seminary college, he did work a brief time in the Tribunal at the Archdiocese of New Orleans. He continues to be a canon law consultant on matters dealing with religious orders and professed religious in the Church, as well as assisting many people with the marriage nullity process.

Many will remember Fr. Charles when he was Sacramental Minister at St. Benedict's from February through May, 2007.
