
Attendance at Meetings

Cost is \$16.00 for AARP members and \$20.00 for non members.

Courses are taught by all volunteers who receive a small amount for gas expenses. Volunteers teach only out of the goodness of their hearts, it's a lot of trouble to prepare for the course and it takes time afterward to do all the paper work. If your insurance company gives a discount and most do, it is good for 3 years. So you do not have to take the course for three years after completion.
