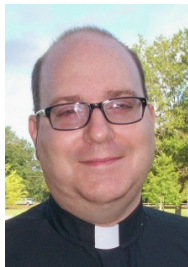
Our fall work day was a huge success, we got a lot done and we are thankful for the help we received from our brothers in the Knights of Columbus.
